Chaufty's awarded honors at Older New Yorkers Day

Several awardees across New York state were honored on Older New Yorkers' Day, Nov. 3. Among the honorees were Lewis County residents James and Christine Chaufty. James and Christine go above and beyond to help people in their community, especially older adults who may not have any family or support. They volunteer for seven different organizations between the two of them, including the food pantry, St. Martin's Church, Salvation Army Red Kettle, Lyons Falls ALIVE, fundraising dinners at St. John's Catholic Church, and the Knights of Columbus. Small Business SPOTLIGHT

HUMBLEBEE FARMS in downtown Lyons Falls began operating last spring.

The Cunninghams purchased their entire system, ready to operate, from a Massachusetts company called Freight Farms. It is a hydroponic system, meaning that plants are grown with a water-based nutrient solution rather than soil. The mineral-rich water is circulated through a sponge-like medium attached to the grow panels. This material is also where the roots embed themselves.

Their operation provides a stark contrast to the industrial farms that supply most grocery





stores. For example, everything produced by the Freight Farm is harvested and sold to locals all in the same day, while massproduced vegetables are shipped across the continent, over the course of several days. (See more information <u>here</u>)

Customers order online and pick up on Thursdays at the farm from 10 a.m. to noon, and at the Lewis County Fairgrounds from 3:30 to 6 p.m. (See more information here)
